

Warriors and Wizards Festival Fan Policy

1. Persons entering the festival assume all risks incidental to the event. Festival staff reserves the right to refuse admission or eject any person violating any law, rule or policy.
2. For the comfort of all attendees, smoking of tobacco, e-cigarettes or other products that produce a vapor or smoke are allowed only in designated smoking areas. No illegal substances are permitted in any gated areas.
3. Please supervise your children at all times. Attendees under age 14 must be accompanied by an attendee age 18 or older.
4. In all situations and circumstances, festival operations, management and security personnel may in their discretion take actions and impose rules and regulations they deem reasonable or necessary for the safe, secure, clean or family-friendly operation of the festival and overall enjoyment of the festival by its attendees. All guests consent to our "Zero Tolerance Harassment Policy."
5. Guests are asked to conduct themselves in a manner appropriate for a family-friendly amusement park. Unruly, disruptive or offensive behavior, including failing to adhere to posted safety regulations, is strictly prohibited. Guests who appear intoxicated, under the influence of illegal substances or exhibit any other illicit or belligerent behavior will be escorted from the park without refund and/or turned over to the proper authorities.
6. Service animals are permitted. All other animals and pets are prohibited. Service animals must remain on a leash or in a harness and under the control of the owner at all times. We ask you do not leave animals on the park perimeter. In such cases the appropriate authorities will be notified.
7. No Weapons or items to be deemed potentially harmful are allowed on the premise of the festival or park grounds. This means this is no conceal and carry weapons are allowed. If asked to comply with a bag check or visual inspection, guests must comply or may be removed from the festival or park grounds. Items purchased for cosplay or from vendors that may be deemed dangerous must be checked by Festival staffed and will be tagged as such. All weapons, costume or otherwise, must abide by the Festival Weapons Policy.
8. Any person who engages in violent, threatening, abusive or otherwise disorderly conduct which tends to provoke a disturbance or incite violence will be ejected from our events. Threats include statements, actions and behaviors that could reasonably be foreseen as having a purpose to inflict physical harm, even if the person making the threat doesn't have the ability to carry out the threat. Disorderly conduct does not require that a disruption actually occur.
9. By entering festival grounds, you are consenting to interview(s), photography, video/audio recording or media collection. You waive all rights or claims you have to the use of these materials. You are agreeing to the festival "Notice of Filming and Photography."
10. Carry-Ins are not allowed on festival grounds unless approved for medical needs. Carry ins include food, beverages, drones, alcohol, laser pointers or any items deemed dangerous or inappropriate. Any alcohol purchased on festival grounds may not leave festival grounds
